Trail Description

The Black Diamond to Mt. Diablo Regional Trail travels from within Contra Loma Regional Park through the foothill woodlands, mixed evergreen forest, chaparral, stream vegetation and exotic plantings of Black Diamond Mines Regional Preserve. The trail exits Black Diamond Mines and travels over 2.62 miles of unincorporated county property before reaching the City of Clayton and the North Boundary of Mt. Diablo State Park.
